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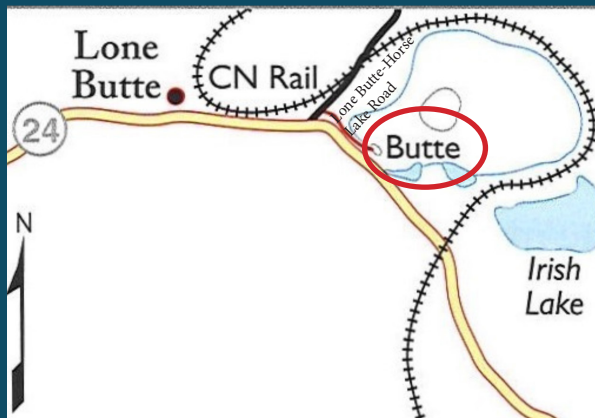

Lone Butte

1km 15min

Lone Butte is a striking basalt volcanic plug offering beautiful views of the surrounding area at its summit, located just east of the town of Lone Butte, alongside HWY 24.

To reach the trailhead, you will turn onto a small access road immediately after the Lone Butte-Horse Lake Road. A public parking lot is located at the base of the Butte. The final 15m is a steep rocky section.



Olsen's Butte

1km 30min

Olsen's Butte offers one of the best vantage points to take in sweeping views of Green Lake and the Marble Mountain Range.

To reach the trailhead, head east on North Green Lake Road. After about 1 km on a dirt road, take the left-hand trail - this is the access route to Olsen's Butte. If you're not driving a high-clearance vehicle, park here or at the nearby cattle guard.

The summit trail follows Snowmobile Trail #10, which begins just to the left of the cattle guard. Follow this trail to reach the top and enjoy expansive views of the surrounding landscape.



Huckleberry Butte

1.5km 30min

Huckleberry Butte offers a gentle climb to a scenic viewpoint overlooking the surrounding forests and lakes.

This scenic hike is easily accessible from Highway 24. Approximately 6 km past Lone Butte, turn right onto Holmes Road. Drive for 1 km, then park and cross the highway to reach the trailhead on the left. Look for the Ministry of Forests and Lands sign warning of cattle at large. Please remember to close the gate.
