












World's Largest X-Country Skis

X-Country Ski Specifics

The giant skis are over 36 feet in length, weigh over 600 pounds each, and are worth close to \$3500.00. The Swix poles came several months later. They measure nearly 27 feet 8 inches and weigh 175 lbs. each. All of the fabrication work was done by Exco Industries. Hillcrest Auto Body did the initial paint job, and sign painter Judy Copland did the detail work. Original Log Homes put up the ski rack and BC Hydro supported in raising the ski & poles.
